

Minutes of meeting between Subcommittee of Admission Committee of Postgraduate Residency Programme Specialized Healthcare and Medical Education Department led by Dr.Asad Aslam & Representatives of YDA Punjab led by Dr.Atif Chaudhry.

In continuation of series of meetings with the representative of YDA Punjab, the final meeting was held on 9th December, 2016.

The following points have been agreed upon between two parties:

- Punjab Residency Program will be run under “Institutional Authority”.
- PG enrolled for two years training in G.Medicine or surgery ,as the case may be ,shall be preferred for level III induction in same institute subject to available slots OR Level three (subspecialty) inductions of already enrolled trainees shall be made in the same institute subject to availability of PG slots.
- The numbers of PG seats may be increased based on benchmark envisaged in PMDC PG Regulations as number of supervisors and bed increases.
- The admission committee of Punjab Residency Programme may consider allocation of the marks for house job undertaken in the public sector hospitals after amending allocation of marks for govt colleges graduates.
- The MO/WMO working in teaching hospitals shall compete in PRP and II be awarded credit of service rendered as per PRP merit formula and regular MO/WMO may be adjusted as per their merit after transfer /deputation as per their merit and subject to availability of vacancy or may be allowed to draw stipend .
- Working hours or PGs shall be fixed by respective head of institution / department in accordance with the needs of hospitals but shall not be more than as prescribed by PMDC rules.
- The wedlock policy for PG trainees shall be devised and implemented subject to availability of seats and without prejudice to the merit of other PGs.PGs already married before inductions shall be considered for this.
- The Maternity leave or unpaid leave shall be allowed as per PMDC/University rules.
- Institution based change of supervisor /institute plan encompassing merit formula shall be prepared as and when vacancy occurs subject to provision of NOC from PMDC and department.
- The department shall make a plan to start minor diplomas / MCPS for in service candidates/MO/WMO as per needs of department and in specialties like anesthesia etc facing shortage.
- The health department will constitute a committee to discuss / resolve the e issue of regularization of adhoc MO/WMO(BS-17) in accordance with the approved Service Structure 2012 after consultation with the law and regulation department.

- 2013 MO/WMO committee working under the chairmanship of Prof Mehmood Shaukat will expedite its proceedings and shall submit recommendations in accordance with already agreed adjustment Policy of MO/WMO and Service Structure 2012.
- The administrations of the institution will resolve the security issues at institution level and department are already working on prevention of violence in hospitals through legislation.
- YDA will call off all form of strike/ agitation and ll not agitate agreed issues again in future and any issue pointed out by YDA shall be dealt expeditiously by department In accordance with law.
