I am, further, directed to inform that as per scheduled program 5000-10000 Indian/ International Sikh Yatrees and locals are expected to participate in the festival held from **04th November 2025 to 13th November 2025** for "**Birthday Celebration of Baba Guru Nanak Dev Ji**" will be celebrated at different Gurdwaras: Above mentioned Hospitals should be kept on **HIGH ALERT** and following instructions should be reiterated

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- i. Availability of Medical, Nursing, Paramedical and support staff including Senior Administrative, security and Medical Staff;
 - ii. Duty rosters of the staff of the relevant dates must be shared with the focal person and to this Department;
 - iii. Functionality of Security Control Rooms;
 - iv. Availability of medicines, IV fluids, Vaccines, anti-snake venom, surgical, non-surgical disposables, medical gases and medical devices;
 - v. Availability of sufficient quantity of Blood Bags of all Blood Groups along with an updated list of Donors and Anti-Serra;
 - vi. Allocation of sufficient number of Beds to meet any eventuality;

- vii. Availability of functional standby generators;
 - viii. Availability of uninterrupted water supply;
 - ix. Availability of functionality of all Bio-medical equipment and machines (X-rays, Ultrasound, CT scan, MRI Machines);
 - x. Fully equipped and functional Operation Theaters;
 - xi. Fully functional Communication System i.e. Telephone exchange and mobile connectivity within the hospital.
 - xii. Proper liaison with Rescue 1122 Services must be ensured for patient transfers and referrals if required;
 - xiii. Co-ordinate with local Administration & District Health Authority (DHA) in case of any medical emergency.
3. In case of any further assistance / co-ordination, contact focal person, Mian Umar Hayyat, SO(Admin), Human Rights and Minorities Affairs Department.
